Answers and Explanations

- 1) **C**It makes sense for Julie and Ray to *play* in the *park*. Choice **(C)** is correct.
 - (A) is incorrect because you do not *cook* in a *bedroom*. The kitchen is the proper room to cook in.
 - **(B)** is incorrect because you do not *fish* in a *hotel*. Most hotels do not have fish in them.
 - (D) is incorrect because you do not eat in a library. Libraries are places to study.
- 2) **B**

The barber uses *scissors* to cut *hair*. You can also use scissors to cut many other things. Choice **(B)** is correct.

- (A) is incorrect because a *knife* is usually used to cut *food*, not paper. You use scissors to cut paper.
- **(C)** is incorrect because you do not use a *shovel* to cut anything. You use a shovel to dig.
- **(D)** is incorrect because you do not use a *hammer* to cut anything. You use a hammer to hit.
- 3) **B**

The kitchen is a part of the house where you cook food. Choice (B) is correct.

- **(A)** is incorrect because it does not make sense to say my dad *prepares* food in the *bathroom*. You use the toilet and take a shower in the bathroom.
- **(C)** is incorrect because it does not make sense to say my dad *bakes* food in the *bedroom*. You sleep in the bedroom.
- **(D)** is incorrect because it does not make sense to say my dad *eats* food in the *attic*. You store things in the attic.
- 4) **B**

A bottle can be filled with water and carried around easily. This is the only answer choice that makes sense. Choice (B) is correct.

(A) is incorrect because you cannot carry a *lake*. A lake is in the ground, so no one can carry it.

- **(C)** is incorrect because although you can carry a *plate*, you cannot fill it with water.
- **(D)** is incorrect because you cannot carry a *pool*. A pool is in the ground, so no one can carry it.

5) **A**

A *landscaper* is someone who works in a garden to grow beautiful plants and trees. Landscapers commonly use shovels, rakes, and wheelbarrows when they are working. Choice **(A)** is correct.

- **(B)** is incorrect because *teachers* do not use shovels, rakes, and wheelbarrows. They use other tools in their jobs.
- **(C)** is incorrect because *police officers* do not use shovels, rakes, and wheelbarrows. They use other tools in their jobs.
- **(D)** is incorrect because *engineers* do not use shovels, rakes, and wheelbarrows. They use other tools in their jobs.
- 6) **C**Soccer is a game that you play with your feet. Basketball is a game that you play with your hands. Choice **(C)** is correct.
 - (A) is incorrect because soccer is not a game that you play with your *head*. Basketball is not a game that you play with your *fingers*.
 - **(B)** is incorrect because soccer is not a game that you play with your *arms*. Basketball is not a game that you play with your *legs*.
 - **(D)** is incorrect because soccer is not a game that you play with your *shoulders*. Basketball is not a game that you play with your *neck*.

7) **C**

A thief is someone who steals things. If a thief *stole* (the past tense of *steal*) a car, the police try to find that thief and bring him or her to justice. Choice **(C)** is correct.

- (A) is incorrect because a thief would not wash my brother's car.
- **(B)** is incorrect because a thief would not *build* my brother's car.
- **(D)** is incorrect because a thief would not *buy* my brother's car.
- 8) **D**

A recipe contains instructions and ingredients for cooking. Therefore a *recipe* is used to *cook*. Choice **(D)** is correct.

- (A) is incorrect because a *spoon* is not used to *drink*. A spoon is used to eat.
- (B) is incorrect because a shovel is not used to build. A shovel is used to dig.
- **(C)** is incorrect because a *toothbrush* is not used to *wash*. A shovel is used to clean.
- 9) **B**

A *band* is a group of musicians who *play* music together. If Mr. Gibbard plays the guitar with a group of other musicians, he is in a band. Choice **(B)** is correct.

- (A) is incorrect because *car* and *uses* do not make sense in the spaces.
- **(C)** is incorrect because *school* and *sings* do not make sense in the spaces.
- **(D)** is incorrect because *house* and *drinks* do not make sense in the spaces.
- 10) **D**It is dangerous to play in a busy street. Therefore, it makes sense to say that playing in a busy street is dangerous. Choice **(D)** is correct.
 - (A) is incorrect because sweet and tasty do not make sense in the spaces.
 - (B) is incorrect because pretty and fun do not make sense in the spaces.
 - **(C)** is incorrect because *clean* and *dirty* do not make sense in the spaces.
